Notes:

- 1) One course in Biological/Life Sciences if prior training does not include a course in biology/life sciences.
- 2) A minimum of 12 units of Graduate Engineering Courses excluding EBS 200, 290, 290C, and 299 are required.
- 3) Upper division courses can not include those required for a B.S. in Biological Systems Engineering. This restriction does not apply to EBS 165.
- 4) A minimum of 21 units for M.S. and 24 units of Graduate and Upper Division Units are required excluding EBS 200, 290, 290C, and 299.
- 5) A minimum of 36 units are required for both the M.S. and M.E. degree programs.

Additional Requirements:

- a) All full time graduate students must register for at least 12 units each quarter of which one unit must be EBS 290C.
- b) The program is to be set up during the first or second quarter of registration. However, advisable changes may be made at the beginning of any quarter, and must be approved by the Program Advisers prior to submission to the Department Graduate Adviser.
